

## PROTOCOL COLLECTION OF WHITE CROAKER SAMPLES

Enforcement and Monitoring Programs
Developed under the EPA-CDFW
Cooperative Agreement.



## Role of CDFW

- Quarterly inspections of wholesalers/distributors/receivers.
- Monthly inspections of commercial fishing vessels in and around the catch ban area.
- Monthly inspections of in-ocean and shoreline recreational fishing areas in and around catch ban area.
- Assist EPA in monitoring for white croakers along PV Shoreline areas including two specified landing locations in Huntington Beach and Terminal Island.



## Role of County Inspectors

Orange County, City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County Environmental Health

- Market inspections conducted jointly with CDFG based on schedule coordinated with CDFG.
- Complete survey checklist summarizing market inspection.



## **ACTION**

- If white croakers were found without proper documentation or were caught within the catch ban area or exceeded the bag limit of 10,
  - CDFG will seize the fish, initiate enforcement proceedings, and contact Gilbane to collect the fish.
- If white croaker is identified in a market by County Inspector,
  - Market has to provide documentation on the source of white croaker and Gilbane is contacted to collect the fish.
